## UWCA Declaration for Action - Indigenous Peoples

The discoveries of bodies at Residential Schools in Canada have uncovered the truth about these schools. Truths that Indigenous Elders have spoken about for decades and were recorded by the Truth and Reconciliation Commission. For those of us who are settlers, we are discovering an aspect of history that wasn't taught in school nor talked about at church or in our homes. It is long past time to address the historic and systemic discrimination of Indigenous Peoples.

*It falls on all people living in Canada to continue the hard work of healing and reconciliation, each in our own way and where possible, together, in our families and communities, in the organizations we work with and belong to, and as a nation. - Philanthropic Community's Declaration of Action*

We need to do this work as individuals and as an organization.
