United Way's Period Promise Campaign is devoted to increasing access to menstrual products so that we can eradicate period poverty in our province. Signing onto the policy agreement is one way that we are addressing the issue, de-stigmatizing menstruation, and working towards helping more people get access to the products they count on.

Period poverty and work in Canada

Period poverty is widespread in Canada. According to United Way's Period Promise Research Project, more than 25% of the people who menstruate have gone through a period without menstrual products. And when people don't have access to menstrual products, they are more likely to stay home, missing school, work, or other important community event.

When it comes to work, the data points to a serious issue. More than 20% of people who menstruate say that they have missed work because they didn't have access to menstrual products. More than 30% have said that they've left work. Period poverty is a widespread issue that has a serious impact on people's ability to access work and make a living in Canada.
